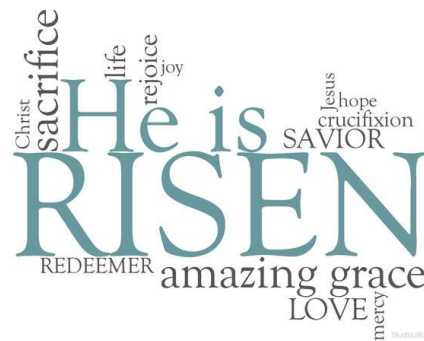

Administrative Professionals Day

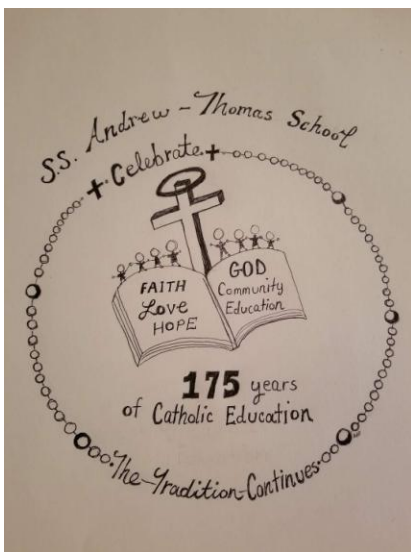
